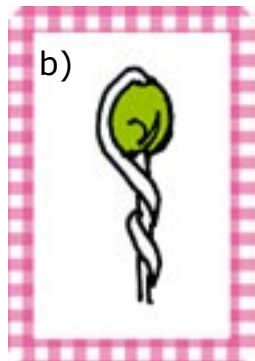
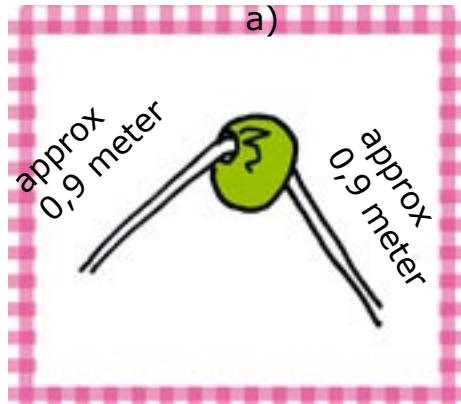


Beaded hanger for childrens clothes



Start bending & twisting here a) & b)

c)

You will need:

Iron wire 1millimetre width and beads. We used beads with 3millimetre holes.

This templet is for a child clothes hanger and if you want it larger just draw from one you like at home. Measure around it and cut a piece of wire double measured length plus 50 centimeters (for twineing). For this hanger approx. 1,80meter.

a) Start with one bead on the middle of the hole wire-length, fold it together and start twisting it b) It's good to twist because you make the wire stiff and you want it to be sturdy. Don't twist it to much though because you must get the beads on so you can't make it to thick.

When the whole wire is twisted you put beads on the twisted wire until you have as long as you need. Bend it in shape after the hanger-form and fasten really well at point c). Cut of the bit you don't need. Cover up c) with a bow of nice ribbon. DONE!
